Program Description:

The Wake Up Tour is an innovative tour that combines Hip-Hop Artists (Rap, Dance, R&B, and spoken word poetry), innovative film technology, actors and motivational speakers that challenge the mindset of youth today while empowering them to make a difference in their community. The Wake Up Tour works as a 55 minute non-stop stage presentation that uses music to speak against violence, crime and social deviance among our youth, while providing direction and a answer to the things that plague our society.

The idea is to charge the atmosphere with positive energy with the help of lighting, sound and visual technology. When the youth enter into the auditorium or where ever the venue is held, they are immediately expecting greatness. Everything that is done is used to capture the attention of the youth so that we can take them on a positive journey of information to avoid the pitfalls in life while empowering them to make a change in their various communities. Every aspect of the tour is set to give the youth a reason and inspiration not to fall prey to violence and social deviance while shaking their consciousness (Waking Them Up).

What is innovative, creative and non-traditional about the program?

The Wake Up Tour has the ability to reach a mass audience with it's hip-hop innovative style. The theatrics that are performed are breathtaking, and inspiring. The artists that participate in this event are genuine recording artists with a passion for serving the community. The tour also brings together young people that model positive examples in the community so that the youth that they service can see them as role-models. The Wake Up Tour also works in the community and with the community helping to nurture change. They host various events for youth as well as partner with other organizations to help continue the outreach that they start once they are allowed to come into the school. The influence of these artists carry a very positive impact in the lives of the students that we reach.

What ages will this program target? How many people will benefit from your program?

The Wake Up Tour works with ages 10 - 21 with a concentration on middle and high school youth. We make a few exceptions in elementary schools whose principals feel that the material of the Wake Up Tour is suitable for their age groups.

The Tour so far has reached over 70,000 youth. This year over 20,000 students will benefit from the presence and message that the Wake Up Tour provides in the school system.

EVALUATION

Recently, the Heal The Hood Foundation Of Memphis partnered with Clear Channel Communications to promote a anti-violence campaign that urged youth to take the anti-violence and social deviance pledge. At this event, hundreds of youth signed the read the pledge and gave their contact information so that they could be tracked and updated on the latest information and events for more positive life changing opportunities. We used the bait of the free special Heal The Hood and K97 commemorative t-shirts to attract the youth to sign up for violence prevention and no gun crimes. The names, complete with telephone numbers, addresses, and MySpace pages would be used to communicate with students that have now submitted themselves to be tracked through our programming. Our tracking unit for measurable objectives have become the following:

MySpace pages – In uses the MySpace pages that have become so popular with youth, we can now have them become friends on our page which means we have an accurate way to not only communicate to our youth, but provide wholesome avenues for resources to help them in troubled situations. We also have the ability to show the numbers of youth that we are reaching as many of them sign up to become friends on our pages.

Signed Documentation – At each event we are allowed the opportunity to provide sign in sheets that will be filed for proof of participation at events. We also provide opportunities for students to get involved with the activities that we use to promote change and healthy lifestyles in our community and abroad by using their talents.

Mapping Of Youth Crime Activity – The police department provides information for criminal activity in various areas according to zipcodes. They also chart what age demographic committed the crimes in certain areas. By using this information, we are able to see a realistic measurement for detouring crime and violence in our areas of concentration.

All Information will be entered into a database to be tracked on a annual basis which will reflect the impact that the Heal The Hood Foundation Of Memphis is having on the city of Memphis and eventually surrounding areas.
